## Methodologies in Cold Case Investigations

**Description:** This dynamic three-day seminar is designed to provide investigators with a comprehensive overview of cold case investigations specifically applicable to missing person, rape and homicide cases. Methodologies and established protocols involving current investigative techniques utilizing recent advances in science and technology will be thoroughly explained and exemplified through case studies. One module will include a two-hour block of instruction on No Body Homicide investigations and prosecution. Attendees will be provided with a list of how to access all resources discussed during the course, including areas such as, phenotyping and forensic genealogy.

The third day of the course will be a cold case review conducted in class on a pre-selected unsolved local case. Therefore, attendees are encouraged to notify the Central Virginia Criminal Justice Academy prior to commencement of the course if they would like to have a case reviewed on the third day.
