Instructor Bio:

- SA Johnny "Chip" Lavender
- Special Agent Johnny Lavender graduated from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Academy in July 2002 and was then assigned to the Tampa field office. SA Lavender investigated White Collar, Civil Rights and Domestic Terrorism cases in Tampa for 12 years. In July 2014, SA Lavender was promoted to Supervisory Special Agent (SSA) at the Humint Operations Unit in Fredericksburg, Virginia where he taught source operation and handling to new agent trainees. In January 2016, SA Lavender accepted an SSA position at the FBI Academy where he supervised the training of new agent trainees. In July 2017, SA Lavender transferred to the Richmond field office and investigated Civil Rights, Fraud Against the Government and Public Corruption matters. SA Lavender is a certified FBI crisis negotiator (2017), a certified FBI adjunct instructor (2014) and a certified FBI Online Undercover Employee (2012).
