**STUDENT CLOTHING/EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS**

<b>CLASS</b>	<b>DATE</b>	<b><u>SPECIAL CLOTHING, MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT</u></b>
All written tests	<b>As scheduled</b>	No. 2 pencil, eraser
Physical Training	<b>January 3, 2024 until end of Academy</b>	Bottled water, towel, soap, running shoes, combination padlock, stocking cap etc. Bring PT clothes until issued PT clothes arrive.
Accident Investigation	<b>March 11-14, 2024</b>	Whistle; Police Traffic Vest.
Firearms Training	<b>February 14-22, 2024</b>	Service weapon,* <b>ammo (SEE NOTE 1)</b> , leather gear, loading device and body armor (if approved by agency for duty), flashlight, range clothing (pants with large baggy pockets for easy retrieval of ammunition is recommended), baseball style hat, rain gear and a pair of protective eyewear. (Eye and ear protection provided.)
Class photos	<b>TBA</b>	Class "A" Uniform shirt, tie and badge.
Firearms Training System (F.A.T.S.)	<b>TBA</b>	Leather gear, flashlight (weapon not necessary.)
Crime Scene Investigation	<b>March 19-26, 2024</b>	Clip board; graph paper, pencils, pens, tape measure, flashlight, index cards, plastic bags--various sizes, boxes--various sizes, pocket knife or scissors, evidence tape--masking tape is adequate, permanent markers, any safety apparel your department may issue for crime scene investigation.
Defensive Driving	<b>Group #1 March 31-April 4, 2024 Group #2 April 7-11, 2024 All Vehicles at Academy Driving dates on Schedule</b>	One vehicle per 2 students per department required. Minimum one vehicle per department. Helmet (Academy provided) flashlight and rain-gear. 2 quarts of oil, 1 bottle brake fluid, 1 bottle power steering fluid.
Defensive Tactics	<b>April 22-May 9, 2024</b>	<b>Required:</b> Gym clothing, soft soled shoes such as tennis shoes, long pants, handcuffs, key, mouthpiece and protective cup for men. <b>No Shorts can be worn during this training</b> 1 or 2 old towels for OC exposure decontamination, 1 can of your agency's OC (the OC CANNOT be expired), and one good thickness hand towel for knife training. <b>Optional:</b> Elbow and knee pads.
Gas House Exercise	<b>May 24, 2024</b>	Gas Mask Note: Academy does not furnish gas masks. Each agency must supply the gas masks.
Officer Survival	<b>May 28-31, 2024</b>	Service weapon, body armor and leather gear. Flashlight, gloves, old warm durable clothing suitable for an outdoor practical problem, rain-gear. You will need 1 Virginia Uniform Summons to complete at Vehicle Stops. <b>Vehicles will be required.</b> <b>* ammo (SEE NOTE 2).</b>
Graduation	<b>June 12, 2024</b>	Class "A" uniform. (Hats not required unless by agency)

**\*Ammunition Requirements:**

**Shotgun (Agency option):** 60 rounds #4 or "00" Buck; **No magnum loads**, 2 3/4" preferred. Avoid synthetic stock, short-barreled shotguns if possible.  
**NOTE 1: Semi-Auto:** Total of 1,850 rounds of ammo (550 rounds must be service ammo - the other 1300 rounds (same grain bullet) may be ball ammo.  
**Revolvers:** Total of 1,850 rounds of ammo (550 rounds must be service ammo - the other 1300 rounds (at least 38+P 125 grain) may be ball ammo.  
**NOTE 2: Semi-Auto:** Total of 200 rounds of ammo (same grain bullet) may be ball or service ammo. **Revolvers:** Total of 200 rounds of ammo (at least 38+P 125 grain) may be ball or service ammo.
