Shotgun (Agency option): 30 rounds #4 or "00" Buck; **No magnum loads**, 2 3/4" preferred. Additional 30 rounds can be birdshot for training purposes or "00" Buck. 60 rounds total needed. Avoid synthetic stock, short-barreled shotguns if possible.

NOTE 1: Semi-Auto: Total of 1,850 rounds of ammo (550 rounds must be service ammo - the other 1300 rounds (same grain bullet) may be ball ammo.

Revolvers: Total of 1,850 rounds of ammo (550 rounds must be service ammo - the other 1300 rounds (at least 38+P 125 grain) may be ball ammo.

NOTE 2: Semi-Auto: Total of 200 rounds of ammo (same grain bullet) may be ball or service ammo.

Revolvers: Total of 200 rounds of ammo (at least 38+P 125 grain) may be ball or service ammo.
